Project Description:

The Maus-Warfield Army Reserve Center is home to four Army units with hundreds of soldiers on drill weekends. The building had fallen into dis-repair with roof leaks causing damage to the interior offices.

Taggart Brown & Associates, Inc., completed the installation of a new 10,700 SF EPDM roof on the main building during Q4, 2017. In addition, we completed re-carpeting 3 offices on the first floor of the building.

The project was completed in 42 working days and included all demo of the existing ballasted roof, coping metal, gutters and downspouts. A new EPDM roof system, metal flashings, gutters and downspouts were professionally installed. Existing rolled carpet was replaced with new carpet squares and cove base in 3 offices with furniture.
