Taggart Brown & Associates was awarded the restoration of the historic bronze entrance doors of the Main Interior Building. The doors are original to the building, constructed in 1936 and have significant damage due to atmospheric pollution, snow melt, and heavy daily use. A second set of doors in the vestibule consisting of bright metal, leading to the entrance lobby on both sides of the building. All doors were left in place and after a thorough cleaning, an architectural coating was applied to bring the original color back to life and to protect from pollution damage moving forward. To prevent improper adhesion of the architectural coatings, work on the exterior set of doors was delayed until late Spring 2022.
