Taggart Brown & Associates was awarded the contract to replace flood-damaged variable frequency drives (VFD) and pumps at the Department of Justice's Robert F. Kennedy Building. In total, the flooding inside the building damaged three VFDs beyond repair. DOJ requested they be replaced with new, state of the art equipment for modernization purposes. After removal of the damaged drives and pumps, the existing wall-mount system was altered to accommodate the smaller equipment being installed. All equipment was tested rigorously to ensure proper integration with the rest of the cooling system and at a larger scale, the building's JCI building automation system.
