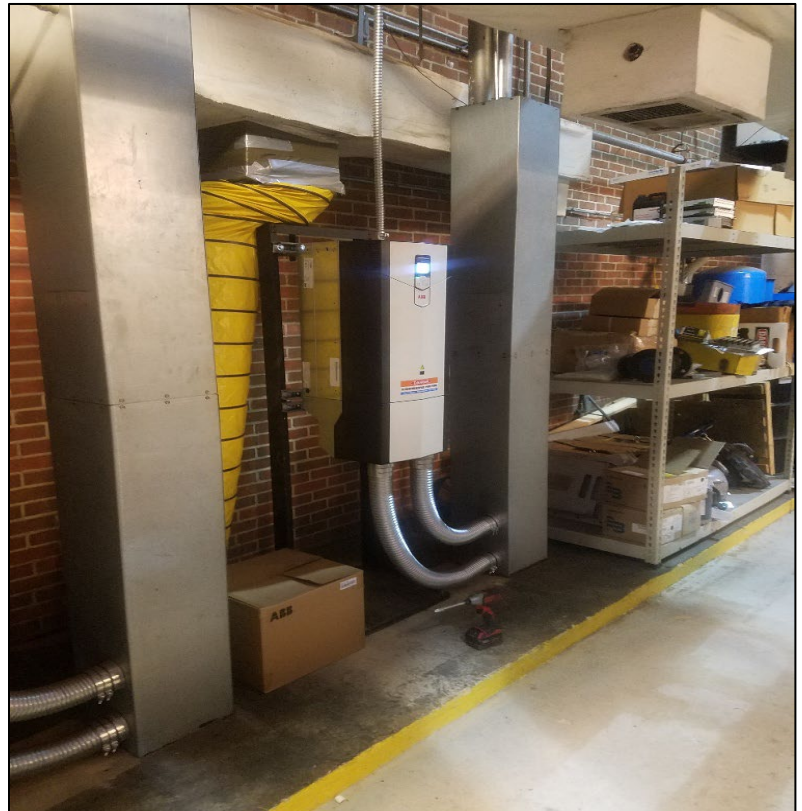

Taggart Brown & Associates, Inc. was direct-awarded a contract to replace two variable frequency drives (VFD) at the Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling in Washington, DC. The two drives are responsible for the cooling of a majority of the buildings located on base that include many top-level White House support agencies. The units were operating at 50% capacity during summertime conditions. During the period between award and mobilization, one of the drives failed completely causing the project to be elevated to an emergency status. Our supplier transported the drives from WI to DC, leading to an accelerated acquisition of materials and start the replacement process three days early. The project took two days to complete and was a huge success.
